Our Vision

We envisage the area returning to its natural state in the next 10 to 20 years as it was approximately 100 years ago. To achieve this, we need to attend to the following:

- 1. To eliminate invasive plant species and reintroduce indigenous plant populations that have disappeared.
- 2. To comprehensively fence the whole area with regular maintenance and patrols to maintain safety.
- 3. To reintroduce the wildlife that used to be here, where practical and possible.
- 4. That the mountain is utilised for recreational and educational purposes by the community.

Membership Fee R250 per annum

- Access to kilometers of mountain biking and hiking trails, horse riding etc.
- One map (see preliminary map at bottom).
- The tranquility, plant, bird and animal life of our beautiful mountain.
- Paid up members get membership cards from the City of Tshwane Nature Conservation. (CoT)
- These membership cards have the Friends Group name and the individual member's name on them. They give each member <u>two</u> free entries for 2 adults and 2 children to each of five of the CoT nature reserves
 - o Rietvlei,
 - o Groenkloof,
 - Wonderboom,
 - Faerie Glen and
 - Rooihuiskraal.

These cards are worth more than R1000 each in terms of the cost of entrance fees.

• Your membership fees will be used to cover the costs to achieve our Vision.

A new payment has to be made each year for a new card to be issued. The cards can be presented at the reception/gate area of each reserve. (The official on duty is supposed to punch a hole in the name of the reserve being entered.)

A general meeting will be held annually to report on actions being undertaken and discuss the way forward.

We also offer a map showing all the trails between Steve Biko Drive and 32 avenue at an additional cost off R50. The example shown below is not the final product but gives an idea what it will be like.
